## Responsibilities

- To serve as Priest for St. John the Apostle Anglican Church;
- Preach and celebrate on scheduled Sunday worship services, as well as Tuesday night prayer services;
- Lead Bible studies, preside at weddings, funerals, special services and pastoral visitations;
- Attend to the pastoral needs of the whole congregation, especially those who are old or ill and unable to attend services;
- Assist with recommendations for children's studies;
- Support the lay ministers who are called to serve in preparation for and during worship;
- Support and grow our ministries - especially among families and young people;
- Willing to work with the Vestry on operational and financial matters and encourage discussions of church needs.





## Parish Setting

St. John the Apostle Anglican Church is located in the northeast suburbs of Detroit, in Clinton Township, Michigan—a diverse, family-friendly community of over 100,000 residents. Parishioners travel from as far as 30 miles to attend services. The surrounding area includes a variety of single-family homes and condominiums and is served by excellent public schools, including the Chippewa Valley School District.

The parish sits on 4.5 acres of serene, wooded land that includes an outdoor chapel and Stations of the Cross, providing a peaceful space for reflection and summer services. Our congregation consists primarily of members 55+, with a growing presence of younger families and children.

St. John the Apostle Anglican Church was founded in 2004 in response to a desire for faithful, traditional Anglican worship grounded in Scripture and historic liturgy. From humble beginnings, we have grown into a steady parish with a commitment to both orthodoxy and outreach.

At the heart of St John the Apostle is our reverent, liturgical worship following the 2019 Book of Common Prayer. The great tradition of Christian music is fully represented, from the earliest Christian hymns to songs from the heart of contemporary Christianity. We currently have on average 40 attendees at each Sunday service with additional members following broadcasted services live on social media. We have a dedicated chapter of Daughters of the Holy Cross who pray and help minister to the needs of the church.
